There are more than 250 different types of shark in the sea. The smallest sharks are called 'dog fish'. They are about one metre long. The largest shark is the enormous 'whale shark'. It is about eighteen metres from nose to tail.




Sharks have very good noses – they find their food with their noses. They smell their food under the water, and then they swim to catch it.

Sharks have very strong tails. Some sharks can swim very fast with their strong tails, but other sharks are slower. The big whale shark cannot swim very fast.

Sharks have very strong, sharp teeth too. They usually catch and eat other, smaller fish, but sometimes they attack people swimming in warmer water near the beach.


